The lighthouse consists of a cast iron outer shell with the interior lined in brick and plaster. There are six decks containing various rooms. The first is the living area and galley, the second and third are sleeping quarters, the fourth is a workroom, the fifth is the gallery with an open-air balcony, and the top contains the lamp.
