The Lighthouse Society Board of Directors is pleased to announce our major capital projects are now completed with the main towers' gleaming new paint job!

The main tower repainting ends a string of major capital restoration projects that also includes rebuilding the fog signal building, the installation of the replica 4th order Fresnel lens in the lantern room, solar power for exterior lighting and the rotating lens, and interior flooring replaced in several areas of the tower.

Hats off to our dedicated restoration and maintenance teams

for contributing countless hours of their skilled labor. We never could've done any of this without their generous assistance. We lost our good friend and restoration team member Bob Letts this year and we will miss him very much.

We want to thank our great group of donors who have been with us through thick and thin to provide the six figure funding amount needed to complete these costly restoration efforts. Whether you took a tour, bought a t shirt, wrote a check or used a paintbrush or a broom, it was all equally important. Our hope is that you now think of this as "our" lighthouse, because for all the reasons above it has truly been a community effort.
